If the body observed is one of the sun s limbs, make the necessary calculations to obtain the sun s centre, as before explained on p. 258, for azimuth, and on p. 259 for altitude; and the resulting angle gives the apparent time in degrees direct, which only requires conversion into time, and the application of the equation of time for the day to be true mean time, that is if the sun be observed west of the meridian; whilst if the sun be observed to the east, the result must be subtracted from twenty-four hours to give true mean time, or from twelve hours for civil time. If the hour angle be large, and the time be required with great accuracy, the equation of time for the day must be computed for the...
